Biographies

Carl Dixon, percussion

Percussionist Carl Dixon is at home with music spanning multiple genres, continents and instruments. He can be found performing in concert halls, jazz clubs, dance parties, festival stages and street parades. Dixon plays with the Brazilian music band Ginga. As a drumset player and percussionist, he has performed/recorded with the Kailin Yong Peace Project, NuMundo, Swing Je T'aime, Casuarina, Alessandro Penezzi, Paula Santoro, Sambadende, Elevations Jazz Orchestra, Pat Bianchi, Jeff Jenkins, Dexter Payne, many musical theater productions and the Rio de Janeiro bloco Bangalafumenga. Dixon is the principal percussionist of the Central City Opera and Fort Collins Symphony, percussionist with Opera Colorado and has performed with the Colorado Symphony, Colorado Ballet, Boulder Philharmonic, Colorado Springs Philharmonic and Greeley Philharmonic Orchestras.

Dixon teaches drumset and world percussion and directs the Latin Jazz and Brazilian Bateria percussion ensembles at the University of Colorado Boulder College of Music. He is the Musical Director of the Boulder Samba School and *Bateria Alegria*, a 20-30 member Brazilian drumming ensemble. He teaches private lessons in all areas of percussion and has presented many workshops at schools, universities, and festivals. Dixon received a Master of Music in percussion performance from the University of Colorado Boulder and a Bachelor of Music from the University of Wisconsin-Madison.
