Biographies

Brian Stone

After four years teaching high school, most recently at Denver East High School, Brian Stone has returned to the University of Colorado Boulder to pursue a DMA in choral conducting and literature. At CU, Stone has led the Collegiate Chorale and University Singers, and directs the vocal jazz ensembles. As a conductor outside of CU, Stone serves as music director of Cantabile Singers, a community ensemble in Boulder, and as choir director at First Unitarian Society of Denver. As a professional singer on the front range, Stone has performed with St. Martin's Chamber Choir, Anima Chamber Ensemble, Evans Choir and Voices of Light. Stone received his BM in voice performance from the University of Puget Sound and MM in choral conducting from the University of Colorado Boulder.

Jordan Hugh Sam

Jordan Hugh Sam directs the Madrigal Ensemble at CU and works as the music director at Guardian Angels Catholic Church in Mead. Previously, he was employed as the assistant choral director at Amherst College, where he directed groups and taught aural skills and music appreciation. In addition to his interest in choral conducting, Sam has worked as collaborative pianist at University of Massachusetts and Amherst College. He maintains an active research interest in the intersection of queer identity and early music, and recently presented his work at the Society for Seventeenth-Century Music. Sam received his BA in music from Amherst College and is currently finishing his MM in choral conducting at the University of Colorado Boulder.
