Personnel

Audrey Murphy is in her sixteenth year at Hopewell Middle School, where she has served as director of bands since the opening of the school. Under her direction, Hopewell ensembles have earned consecutive superior ratings in performance evaluation appearances, and have appeared as guest performing ensembles at the University of Georgia Middle School Band Festival, the Music for All Southeastern Regional Concert Band Festival and the Music for All National Concert Festival. Most recently, the Hopewell Middle School Symphonic Band was selected as a featured performing ensemble for the 2019 Georgia Music Educators Association In-Service Conference, marking their second appearance at the annual state convention. A native of Columbia, South Carolina, Murphy is a graduate of East Carolina University where she served as head drum major of the Marching Pirates as well as principal clarinetist of the symphonic band, wind ensemble and symphony orchestra. Her additional performance experience includes the Long Bay Symphony Orchestra, the Charlotte Civic Orchestra, the Capital City Opera Company of Atlanta, Tara Winds and Atlanta-based woodwind quintet Highland5. She is currently a clarinetist and member of the board of directors for the Georgia

Wind Symphony. Murphy has served as a guest clinician and adjudicator in Georgia, Alabama, North Carolina, South Carolina and Utah. She has received the National Band Association's citation of excellence on four occasions for her contributions to the field of concert band. She is a recipient of the North Fulton Jaycees Outstanding Young Arts Professional Award, and was named 2010-2011 Teacher of the Year for Hopewell Middle School. Murphy holds membership in Sigma Alpha Iota, Pi Kappa Lambda, Phi Beta Mu, the National Association for Music Education and the Georgia Music Educators Association. She has led middle school band curriculum development for Fulton County Schools and serves as chair of the Alfred Music Young Band Competition Contest for the National Band Association.

Shanti Simon is the director of bands at the University of Oklahoma where she conducts the Wind Symphony and leads the graduate and undergraduate wind conducting programs. Prior to joining the faculty, Simon was the flight commander and associate conductor with The United States Air Force Academy Band in Colorado Springs. Before moving to Colorado, Simon served as flight commander and associate

conductor with The United States Air Force Band in Washington, D.C., where she conducted performances in the national capital region and around the country, including the 2011 National Tree Lighting Ceremony with the Airmen of Note hosted by President Obama and the First Family. Simon was on the faculty of Shenandoah Conservatory as the associate director of bands for the 2013-2014 academic year. In 2016, Simon deployed to the Middle East with the United States Air Force Central Command bands as the officer-in-charge, overseeing musical troop-support, community-outreach and partnership-building missions in seven countries. Before joining the Air Force, Simon earned her MM and DMA degrees in conducting from the University of Minnesota where she studied with Craig Kirchhoff. She received her BME and BM degrees from Stetson University with Bobby Adams. Hailing from Florida, Simon served as the associate director of bands at Vero Beach High School for four years, where her ensembles consistently earned top ratings in all areas of district and state assessment. Simon is active nationally and internationally as a guest conductor and clinician.

Donald J. McKinney conducts the CU Wind Symphony, guides the graduate wind conducting program and oversees the university's comprehensive band program. McKinney was previously the director of wind ensembles and associate professor at Louisiana State University. While teaching at LSU, McKinney and the Wind Ensemble were invited to perform for the 2013 CBDNA National Conference in Greensboro, North Carolina. McKinney has held additional faculty positions at Interlochen Center for the Arts and Duquesne University Mary Pappert School of Music. As a guest conductor, he has appeared with the Dallas Wind Symphony, Concordia Santa Fe, Boulder Philharmonic Orchestra and Greater Boulder Youth Orchestra. He has also conducted concerts and clinics in Costa Rica and Canada. McKinney has presented conducting master classes at the University of Central Florida, Eastern Washington University, University of

Central Missouri, West Chester University, and the University of California, Los Angeles. His recording credits include projects with the Dallas Winds—including *John Williams at the Movies*, which was nominated for a Grammy Award in 2019— University of Michigan Symphony Band, University of Texas Wind Ensemble and others. McKinney has published articles in numerous conducting resources, including five volumes of *Teaching Music through Performance in Band* and in *The Conductors Companion*. He also authored a chapter about Pulitzer Prize-winning composer Jennifer Higdon for the book *Women of Influence in Contemporary Music*. After participating in the second Frederick Fennell Conducting Masterclass, he was named a finalist for the Thelma A. Robinson Award by the Conductors Guild. McKinney has been nominated for a LSU Alumni Association Faculty Excellence Award and is an honorary member of Kappa Kappa Psi. He holds degrees from Duquesne University, Indiana University of Pennsylvania and the University of Michigan.
