Retirement Party and Fundraiser In celebration of Nada Diachenko

3 p.m., Sunday, April 26th Charlotte York Irey Theatre

Nada Diachenko, our fearless innovator and somatic super goddess, is retiring after more than 30 years in dance in higher education at the University of Colorado/Boulder. Nada was recently named a Living Legend in Dance in choreography for her career as a performer, choreographer, teacher, somatic therapist and artistic director.

Nada served as director of the Dance Program from 1989 to 2001 and continues as a professor and somatic specialist today. Taking the nationally known program created by Charlotte Irey, Nada worked diligently and innovatively to situate CU as a vanguard program moving into the 21st century. She led the dance faculty in curricular changes, facility expansion and on- and off-campus outreach, while writing grants to support all of the changes and additions. She founded the CU Contemporary Dance Works Graduate Company, the longest running outreach program on campus, now in its 29th consecutive year touring rural Colorado in the summer.

A soloist with the Erick Hawkins Company for a decade, Nada also served as the artistic director and vice president for the Board of the Greenhouse Ensemble (NYC); founder and artistic director for Nada Diachenko: Solo Dance and Nada Diachenko and Dancers (NYC); artistic director and director of the school The Dance Place (NYC); founder and co-director of The Berlin Dance Ensemble (Germany) with former Tharp dancer Ken Rinker; and dancer with Ethel Butler Modern Dance Company (Washington, DC.) Her reach is global, as she has taught classes in technique, choreography, repertory, Alexander Technique, injury prevention and exercise theory as a guest artist in Costa Rica, the Czech Republic, Denmark, England and Brazil.
