# Biographies

**Michael Thornton** is Associate Professor of Horn at the University of Colorado Boulder. He also serves as Principal Horn of both the Los Angeles Chamber Orchestra and the Colorado Symphony. He has performed as a soloist, orchestral musician, chamber musician and clinician on six continents, and is grateful to have seen the world through his musical endeavors.

**Margaret McDonald** is Associate Professor of Collaborative Piano at the University of Colorado Boulder. She is also a member of the collaborative piano faculty at Music Academy of the West. She tours and performs regularly, and is recognized internationally for her excellence and musical sensitivity.

**Michael Hoffman** is a recent graduate of the Master of Music in Vocal Performance Program at the University of Colorado Boulder. He is currently developing his private voice studio and performed Auf dem Strom following his presentation in the school's showcase at Carnegie Hall last fall.

**Michael Tetreault** is Lecturer in Percussion at the University of Colorado Boulder. He serves as Principal Timpanist of the Central City Opera and performs with many regional ensembles throughout Colorado. He has performed and recorded with premier ensembles throughout Europe and North America.

**Julie Thornton** is Instructor of Flute at the University of Denver Lamont School of Music. She also plays piccolo with the Colorado Symphony. Her work with many of the country's renowned ensembles has taken her across the world as a performer and pedagogue.

Clark Stewart is currently pursuing a Master's degree in Horn Performance and Pedagogy at the University of Colorado Boulder. He holds degrees from UMKC Conservatory of Music and Cincinnati College Conservatory.

The Colorado COR Horn Quartet is comprised of four outstanding CU horn students who are from Colorado. This auditioned ensemble speaks to both the excellence of horn playing in Colorado and CU's commitment to cultivating the best talent from our region. Former members are now at prestigious institutions including The Juilliard School and hold positions in orchestras throughout the world.
